The Healthy Start Coalition is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization led by a volunteer board of directors. Our services are provided by trained professionals known as Healthy Start Care Coordinators Our Okaloosa County Services Provider is Chautauqua Healthcare Services and our Walton County Service Provider is the Walton County Health Department.









To keep our staff and clients safe, all home visiting services are being provided via phone or video conferencing. Here is one story sharing how Nancy DeJesus, a Healthy Start Care Coordinator, supported her client through the COVID-19 Pandemic.

On top of dealing with the COVID-19 pandemic and having a newborn in the home, this Healthy Start Client and her children have fallen on hard times since her husband was detained by Immigration Services. This family has relied on the kindness and generosity of their community. Healthy




Start Care Coordinator, Nancy, helped connect her client with Spanish churches in the community to provide them with support, food, and other necessities. Nancy also helped them to obtain an attorney that specializes in immigration law and spoke their language so that the client could communicate affectively and work to get her husband released. This family is very grateful for the non-judgmental support and help they have received from Healthy Start and their community.

Fighting the Spread of COVID19 - Update
